Because bakers work from really early in the morning so they're ready for people around breakfast- You probably know this- He didn't-Anyway: "So at a night bakery, the bakers would work through the day and then open around dinner time." "Who would even come to a night bakery?" he said. "Restaurants! People having soup for dinner, people who forgot to buy dessert to take to a party! And what about people coming home late after a night out? Imagine being blind drunk and stumbling across a bakery at two in the morning selling chocolate croissants ... you'd buy fifty!"
